Directions to Malungen:

From **Oslo** follow E6 north towards **Gardermoen/Trondheim**. Exit E6 at **Kløfta**, follow RV2 towards **Kongsvinger**. At **Skarnes**, exit RV2 and follow FV24 northbound towards Stange. Malungen is located on the left hand side after about 40 km from Skarnes.

Trial locations:

Saturday: Team trial will be held 13 km north of Malungen in Stange County. A local farmer has given us the opportunity to compete on fields nearly designed for Retriever work. We look forward to challenge you in a simulated partridge and rabbit hunt.

Sunday: Individual trial at [Malungen Gjestegård](http://www.malungen.com). Malungen is situated nearby small lakes and rivers, and offers fields especially good for hunting ducks. We will do our best to simulate a traditional duck hunt at Malungen, and we look forward to see dogs compete in a challenging environment.

Both trails are official Norwegian B-trails

Schedule:

Friday - Registration at Malungen from 18:00.

Saturday - Welcome and opening at Malungen at 08.00. Joint departure to trail site afterwards.

Prior to the dinner on Saturday, there will be a short seminar on the topic " How can we best cooperate to develop the best possible working flat coated retriever?". The team captain from every team is hereby asked to present the current praxis in their club / association (demands to be included on the puppy-list (valpeliste), connected titles, inbreeding control / restrictions, etc.). The introductions will be followed by a discussions were we all take part!

Sunday - Individual trial start 08.30.

Please note that the group order for the team trial on Saturday has been pre drawn and presented in the catalogue.

The Sunday trail will include water-work for the dogs. Since it is cold this time a year, please take adequate percussions.

Judges, competitors, spectators and NC 11 crew are invited to stay at Malungen Gjestegård.

Friday to Sunday, all inclusive (except beverages) NOK 1990,-

Dogs are allowed in house "Bjørkhaug" for an additional tax of NOK 200,-

Competitors are given priority to access booking of "Bjørkhaug". All competitors must inform Malungen when booking to gain priority.

NC 11 secretary is open at Malungen from Friday at 6.00 pm.

NOK 400,- pr trial, payment in cash at registration.

Payment for quarters is a subject between Malungen and each participant. Malungen accepts credit cards.

Regulations and vaccinations:

Please be prepared to show valid proof of vaccination upon registration. Note: last vaccination can not be later than 3 years. Please bring your dog passport with you, and please note the Norwegian regulations regarding cross border transfer of dogs. See
